Team Description – A place to facilitate a space where young people can encounter the presence of God through worship and prayer.

Roles & Responsibilities

Requirements:

- A passion for facilitating a space where young people can both pursue and encounter the presence of God, through worship and prayer.
- Ideally, some confidence in praying out loud for young people and familiarity with altar ministry.
 - Available to serve during at least two late evening sessions (9pm-11pm)
 - Communications skills to connect with young people

Responsibilities:

- **Intercession:** Gather before each session to pray over the young people, sharing any words with the team.
- **Prayer Ministry:** Be attentive and available to pray with young people, whether through altar calls or personal requests.
 - **Practical Support:** Assist with venue preparation, whether setup or tear-down.
- **Team Collaboration:** Provide active support to team leaders, responding to their directions and contributing to a team effort.
- **Model Engagement:** Set an example of hunger and engagement during worship and prayer teams.

In addition to your specific roles all team members are asked to take responsibility for the wellbeing and safety of young people and follow emergency protocols as needed.

Hours – All teams work on a shift pattern, you will either work a morning, afternoon or evening shift, no more than 8 hours a day.

Minimum Age: 16

DBS Required: Yes

Reference: Every volunteer is required to have had a reference by someone who has had leadership responsibility for them for at least a year. This ideally needs to be a church leader, youth worker but also can be a work manager or teacher.
