Your role is to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all participants, making sure that no one misses out on all the fun! ?

Roles & Responsibilities

Help create a safe and fun environment for young people to enjoy
Manage large inflatables ensuring health and safety guidelines are properly followed
help manage queues for silent disco and dj evenings. Ensuring safety for all both inside and outside the venue
Behaviour management of young people both inside the venue and those queuing Engage with young people that come into the venue.
Assist with afternoon activities happening within the venue

In addition to your specific roles all team members are asked to take responsibility for the wellbeing and safety of young people and follow emergency protocols as needed.

Hours – All teams work on a shift pattern, you will either work a morning, afternoon or evening shift, no more than 8 hours a day.

Minimum Age: 16

DBS Required: Yes

Reference: Every volunteer is required to have had a reference by someone who has had leadership responsibility for them for at least a year. This ideally needs to be a church leader, youth worker but also can be a work manager or teacher.
