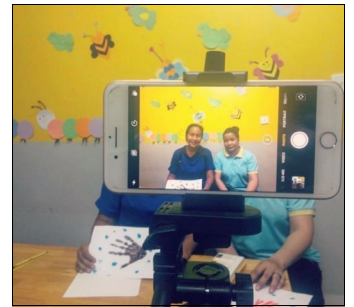
The girls and staff have continued to study English and each morning they have devotions and can share their prayer requests and worship God together.
