



BSL Interpreting Team

Team Description – The BSL team is there to make sure that everyone is included whilst at festival. Join this team if you are someone who can provide sign language to those young people who require it. This role is so key in making sure that everyone, regardless of their hearing abilities, can fully enjoy and engage at festival.

Roles & Responsibilities

The BSL team serve in the main venue at Limitless Festival, interpreting all the main session content from worship to the word. The main venue has two sessions a day; a morning session and evening session. All team members will alternate in the main venue. You may be asked to interpret in some of our other venues for seminars throughout the day.

In addition to your specific roles all team members are asked to take responsibility for the wellbeing and safety of young people and follow emergency protocols as needed.

Hours – All teams work on a shift pattern, you will either work a morning, afternoon or evening shift, no more than 8 hours a day.

Minimum Age: 18

DBS Required: Yes

Reference: Every volunteer is required to have had a reference by someone who has had leadership responsibility for them for at least a year. This ideally needs to be a church leader, youth worker but also can be a work manager or teacher.
