Team Description - Are you an energetic and creative individual who loves working with kids? Your responsibilities will include organizing and supervising fun activities and ensuring the safety and happiness of the children throughout the festival.

Roles & Responsibilities:

- · Attend pre-festival team meeting
- · Join a festival kids team WhatsApp
- Read, acknowledge and understand safeguarding and safety rules surrounding working with children.
 - Serve in one of 3 age groups: 0-3, 4-7, 8-11.
 - · Create a warm and inviting atmosphere for every child.
 - Keep Jesus at the centre of all we do.
 - To be in amongst the children throughout the programme.
 - Follow the direction of room leaders including the kids team lead.
 - Be available for set up and pack down around each session and bookending festival.
 - There is potential to help with games, hosting, activities, worship.
 - · Aiding with toileting needs where necessary.
 - Clear communication with other members of team.
 - Be flexible to fill in gaps as and when it's needed.
 - Come expectant, ready and excited for a brilliant time with the children at festival

In addition to your specific roles all team members are asked to take responsibility for the wellbeing and safety of young people and follow emergency protocols as needed.

Hours – All teams work on a shift pattern, you will either work a morning, afternoon or evening shift, no more than 8 hours a day.

Minimum Age: 16

DBS Required: Yes

Reference: Every volunteer is required to have had a reference by someone who has had leadership responsibility for them for at least a year. This ideally needs to be a church leader, youth worker but also can be a work manager or teacher.
