

Youth For Christ

Roles:

You may be asked or required to do any or all of the following:

- To serve in the café area of the venue which includes serving on the tills, making drinks, ensuring the area is tidy, picking up extra supplies onsite etc.
- To engage with young people in the venue through conversation and relationship building activities
 - To help tidy and clean the venue before, during and after opening times
 To lead a seminar or support the seminar programme
 - To help prep the venue for afterhours or other activities that require additional set-up (eg. Christmas theme open mic night)
 - To aid in the running of afterhours activities

Responsibilities:

- To help support the wider experience of young people at Limitless Festival by providing a safe, positive and welcoming environment in which to chill out and attend seminars
- To be open to what God might be wanting to do or say whilst in the café/Youth for Christ space
 To attend all devotional, briefing and debrief times
- To be in the venue during all times scheduled as per the rota sent out by the team lead and to be on time when scheduled to be in the venue
 - To adhere to all safeguarding policies laid out by Limitless festival
 - To report to team leads and undertake any other tasks as required

In addition to your specific roles all team members are asked to take responsibility for the wellbeing and safety of young people and follow emergency protocols as needed.

Hours – All teams work on a shift pattern, you will either work a morning, afternoon or evening shift, no more than 8 hours a day.

Minimum Age: 16

DBS Required: Yes

Reference: Every volunteer is required to have had a reference by someone who has had leadership responsibility for them for at least a year. This ideally needs to be a church leader, youth worker but also can be a work manager or teacher.
