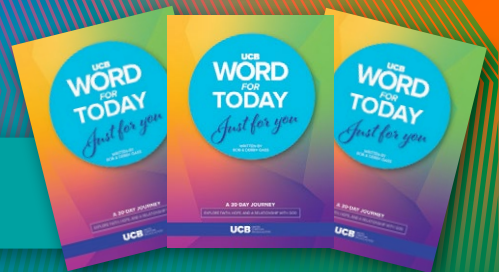
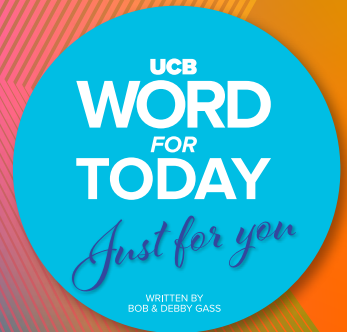
LEADERSHIP

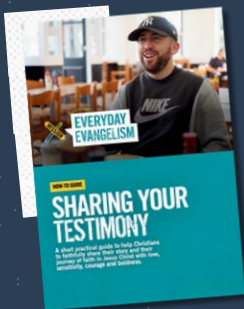

Offering

During our time together, we will be receiving an offering — one we will give away in its entirety to the Assemblies of God (AoG) Church Planting Programme.

This is a deliberate act of generosity, a choice to be a blessing rather than simply to receive one. It would be easy to adopt a poverty mindset — to hold tightly to what we have, convinced that scarcity means we must keep all we can. But we believe in a different economy: one shaped by trust in a God who not only meets our every need but empowers us to bless others extravagantly.

Solomon reminds us that “the world of the generous gets larger and larger; the world of the stingy gets smaller and smaller” (Proverbs 11:24, MSG), and Paul assures us that “God will cause

you to prosper so that you can be generous on every occasion” (2 Cor 9:11, paraphrase). When we give, we are not diminishing ourselves — we are joining the generous movement of God in the world, investing in new communities of faith that will carry the Gospel forward for generations to come.

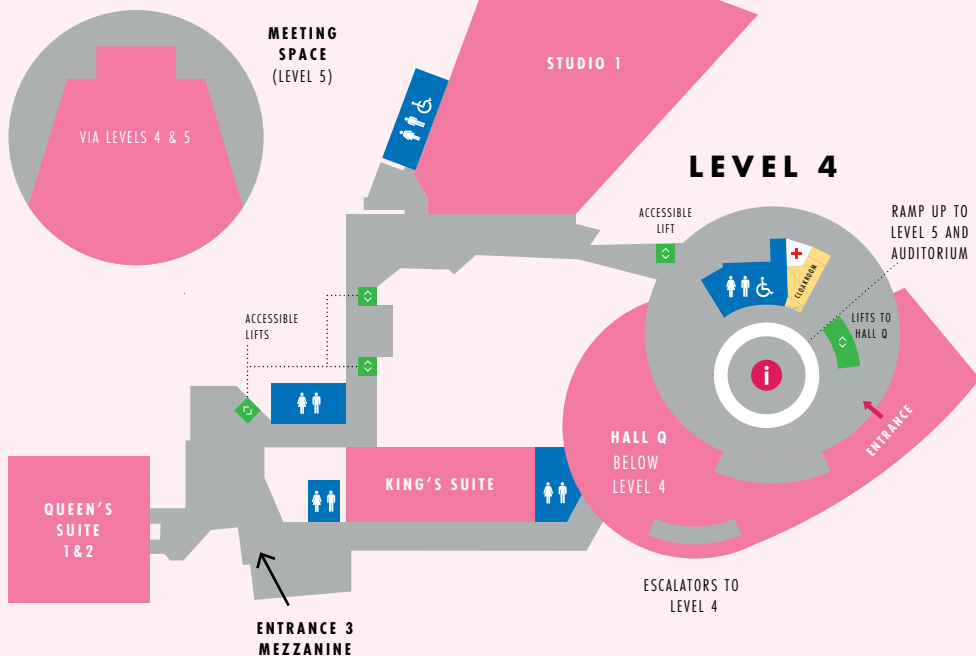

This section is designed to help us respond to what we sense God is saying in this season.

Under the theme Eyes of Faith, we are invited not just to see differently, but to lead differently, with renewed attentiveness to the Spirit and fresh alignment with God's purposes. Each of the fivefold graces offers both a declaration to shape our posture and practical steps to help cultivate healthy, Spirit-led cultures in our churches and teams.

Our prayer is that this resource would not simply inform, but prompt reflection, conversation, and courageous action as we lead God's people forward.

Apostolic: **Ploughing New Ground**
Prophetic: **Seeing and Hearing God Anew**

DECLARATION

Ploughing New Ground

We declare that we are a people called to plough up new ground. With eyes of faith, we imagine new possibilities, embrace fresh vision, and forge new courage for the days ahead. We will not be limited by what has been but will step boldly into what God is doing now.

BIBLICAL FRAMING

Isaiah 43:18–19 *“See, I am doing a new thing... do you not perceive it?”*

PASTORAL VISION

A healthy apostolic culture is not restless but faithful, courageous, and forward-looking. It honours legacy while refusing to be trapped by it. It creates space for risk, innovation, and obedience.

FIVE PRACTICAL WAYS FORWARD

- 1. Name the New:** Regularly articulate where you sense God leading next, not just what He's done before.
- 2. Create Permission for Courageous Faith Steps:** Celebrate obedience even when outcomes aren't perfect.
- 3. Empower Sending Cultures:** Release people into ministry beyond the church building.
- 4. Keep Mission Central:** Align strategy, appointments and spending around God's outward movement.
- 5. Guard Against Nostalgia:** Honour history without letting it dictate the future.

LEADERSHIP DISCUSSION:

- Where might we be clinging to the familiar rather than perceiving the new?
- What steps of courageous faith is God inviting us to take in this season?
- How do we celebrate obedience, not just success?

Prophetic DECLARATION

Seeing and Hearing God Anew

We declare that this is an opportunity for God's people to receive a fresh revelation of the Lord. With eyes of faith, we seek to further understand God's heart and to freshly discern His voice. We posture ourselves to listen, to respond, and to be led by the Spirit of God.

BIBLICAL FRAMING

Joel 2:28 *"I will pour out my Spirit on all people..."*

PASTORAL VISION

Healthy prophetic culture is accessible, accountable, and loving. It builds faith, not fear. It listens more than it speaks and always points people toward Jesus.

FIVE PRACTICAL WAYS FORWARD

- 1. Normalise Listening Prayer:** Create regular, safe spaces to wait on God together.
- 2. Anchor Prophecy in Love:** Measure prophetic ministry by its fruit, not its volume.
- 3. Develop Discernment Muscles:** Teach how to weigh, test, and interpret prophetic insight.
- 4. Invite All Generations:** Expect God to speak through the young, the old, and everyone in between.
- 5. Resist Celebrity Culture:** Prioritise community discernment over platformed voices.

LEADERSHIP DISCUSSION:

- Do people feel safe to listen and share what God may be saying?
- How do we model humility in prophetic leadership?
- Are we forming discernment, not dependency?

DECLARATION

Renewed Commitment to the Mission

We declare a renewed and unwavering commitment to the Great Commission. With eyes of faith, we see people as God sees them and carry the good news of Jesus with love, courage, and hope. We are sent people, confident in the power of the gospel and faithful to the mission entrusted to us.

BIBLICAL FRAMING

Isaiah 52:7 “How beautiful... are the feet of those who bring good news.”

PASTORAL VISION

Evangelism flows from love, presence, and hope, not pressure. It is relational, incarnational, and rooted in the confidence that God is already at work.

FIVE PRACTICAL WAYS FORWARD

- 1. Reframe Evangelism as Overflow:** Help people share faith naturally from lived experience.
- 2. Equip Everyday Witness:** Train the church to live a life on mission every day.
- 3. Build Bridges into Community:** Create spaces where belonging comes before believing.
- 4. Celebrate Stories of Transformation:** Regularly share testimonies of faith journeys.
- 5. Pray for Spiritual Openness:** Keep prayer central to mission, not activity alone.

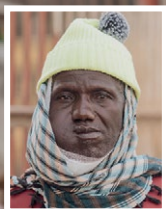

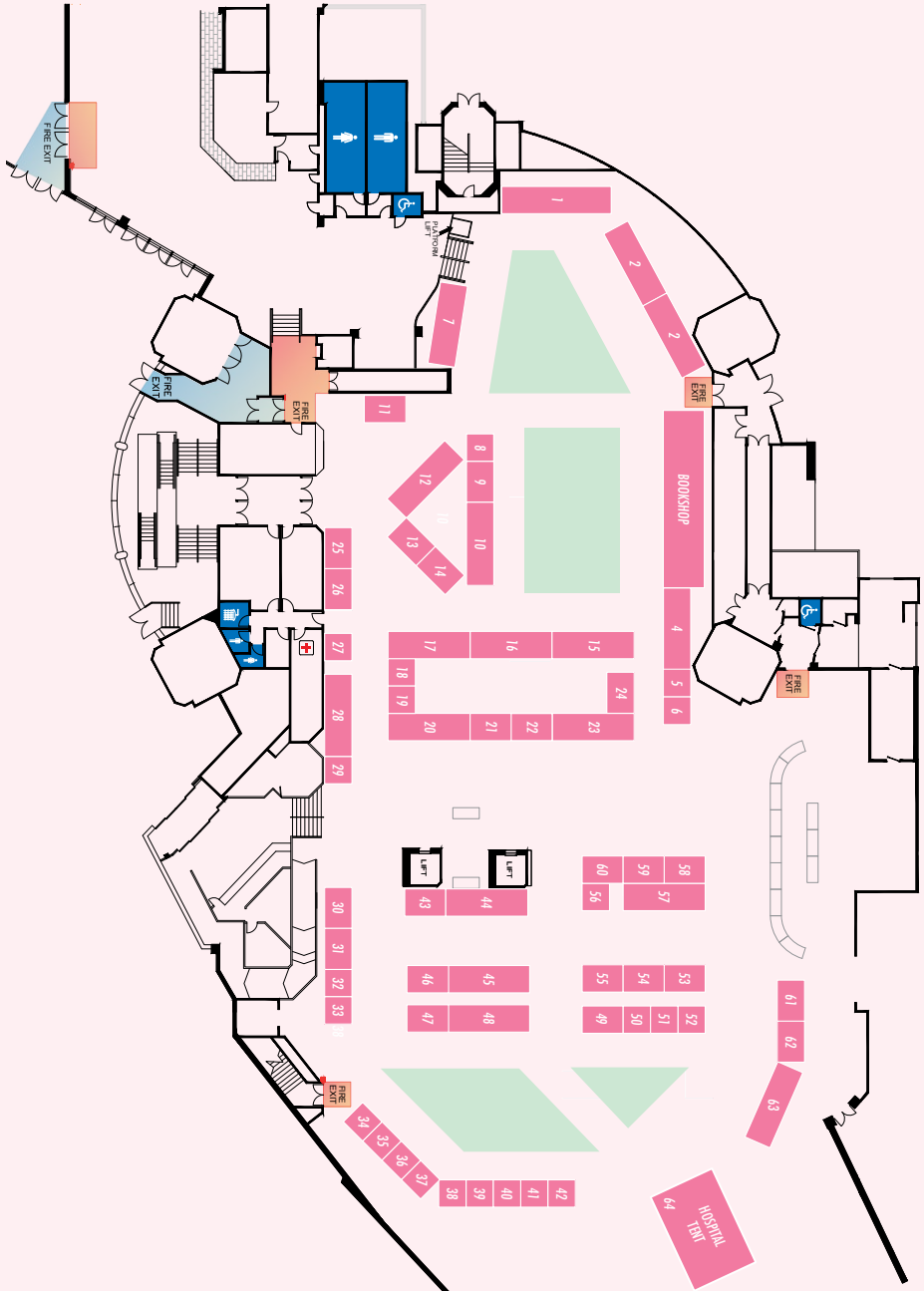
